Highlights



Dramatic Situation in Haiti

Fifteen years on from the devastating earthquake, the humanitarian situation in Haiti remains critical. For many people, hunger, violence and instability are the order of the day. In 2025, Jugend Eine Welt continued supporting projects in cooperation with local partner organisations in the country with a focus on education, training and emergency relief.

January



World Health Day

On World Health Day, attention was drawn to the inadequate access to medical care that persists in many parts of the world. In 2025, Jugend Eine Welt again supported medical projects like the one in Kulmasa in northern Ghana where a family clinic and mobile health teams provide health care for the population.

March



Day for Street Children

To mark the Day for Street Children, Jugend Eine Welt highlighted the precarious situation of the millions of children around the world who have no fixed abode. Together with long-term project partners, the organisation emphasised the importance of protection, education and stable guidance for providing the children in question with viable prospects and a life in dignity.

January

New Children's Shelter Opens in Lagos

In Lagos, Nigeria, a new shelter for children, built with funds provided by Jugend Eine Welt, was officially opened. The facility offers accommodation for around 100 street children as well as access to health care, psychosocial support, schooling and preparation for a working life. In a city where tens of thousands of children have no fixed abode, the shelter is a haven that offers stability and new opportunities to particularly vulnerable young people.



May



Three Years of War in Ukraine

Three years after Russia began its war of aggression, the Ukrainian people are still suffering the effects of the hostilities, the destruction and supply bottlenecks. Together with project partners in the country, Jugend Eine Welt provided aid, especially in the southern Ukrainian port of Odessa.

February



Vital Help Reaches Ghana

In Kulmasa, a remote region in northern Ghana, diseases such as hepatitis, malaria and typhus are widespread. Jugend Eine Welt supported a vaccination project run by the Medical Mission Sisters as well as education projects including an elementary school that gives the pupils a hot meal every day.

May



Earthquake Relief in Myanmar

Following the major earthquake in Myanmar, hundreds of thousands were left homeless and exposed to extreme weather. As an immediate relief measure, Jugend Eine Welt supported local project partners with the distribution of essential supplies such as tarpaulins, mosquito nets, blankets and mats.

March

Campaign Against Child Labour

As part of the "Kinderarbeit stoppen" (stop child labour) initiative, Jugend Eine Welt marked the World Day Against Child Labour with a powerful statement against the exploitation of children. Interactive stations and a large-scale dance event at Vienna's MuseumsQuartier highlighted the global extent of child labour and the necessity for effective action.



June



June

Support from Justice Minister Sporrer

In the run-up to the World Day Against Child Labour, the "Kinderarbeit stoppen" initiative against child labour, of which Jugend Eine Welt is a member, met the Austrian Minister for Justice, Anna Sporrer. During the meeting, the importance of resolute action against child labour at European level was emphasised.

President Van der Bellen Visits COOKtastic

During his state visit to South Africa, Austrian president Alexander Van der Bellen inspected the COOKtastic Hub in Cape Town. This cookery school for underprivileged youngsters stems from an earlier Jugend Eine Welt project and offers young people new opportunities for learning a trade.



July

Day of Indigenous Peoples

In cooperation with the provincial government of Tyrol, Jugend Eine Welt supported projects in favour of indigenous women who live as small farmers in Ecuador. Training in agricultural methods and business strategies increased their food security and enhanced their position in their families and communities for the long term.



August

My Heart Beats for Africa

In Mariazell, a large number of guests witnessed an inspirational evening of insights into the work done by Jugend Eine Welt. Board member Dr Magdalena Griebler, medical chief of the town's health centre, gave an account of her assignments as a volunteer in Ethiopia and Ghana where Jugend Eine Welt supports numerous projects including some focusing on medicine.



September

Fundraiser of the Year

Jugend Eine Welt director and co-founder Reinhard Heiserer was chosen as "Fundraiser of the Year" at the Austrian Fundraising Awards. He was recognised for his many years of dedication, his innovative drive and his contribution to promoting philanthropy in Austria.



October

Shaping the Future Through Education

In the megacity of Lagos, Jugend Eine Welt and the provincial government of Tyrol supported vocational training for young people. Practical courses were held for young women in particular and covered activities such as dress-making, baking, cosmetics and IT to equip them with what they need to stand on their own two feet.



October

Meeting with Vice-Chancellor Babler

Jugend Eine Welt director Reinhard Heiserer and the "Kinderarbeit stoppen" alliance against child labour met Austria's vice-chancellor Andreas Babler. The meeting focused on the importance of a strong European supply chain policy as a means of effectively combating child labour all over the world.



October

Award for Jugend Eine Welt

In Vienna, Jugend Eine Welt received recognition as a family-friendly employer. Following the successful certification procedure, director Reinhard Heiserer and HR manager Maria Ekl-Jürgens accepted the certificate from Claudia Bauer, Federal Minister for Europe, Integration and Family.



November

Rehabilitation Centre for Children in Bethlehem

With the support of the Austrian Ministry for Social Affairs, Jugend Eine Welt provided funds for the Lifegate rehabilitation centre near Bethlehem in Palestine. Here, children with a disability receive medical care and therapy, while families are given assistance with obtaining important equipment.

Jugend Eine Welt Projects that Illustrate our Work:

Ethiopia - Drinking Water for the People in Tigray

In collaboration with the Salesians of Don Bosco, Jugend Eine Welt successively renovated three watering places in the towns of Shire, Adwa and Mekelle as part of a project supported by the Austrian Development Agency. These facilities will give an estimated 10,000 people regular access to water for their household needs. In addition, they have been made barrier-free so that war invalids (especially young men) and people with a disability can use them without difficulty. A solar-powered pump was also installed for the well at the Salesians' site in Adwa to ensure uninterrupted operation despite the frequent power outages.

Nigeria - New Children's Shelter Opens in Lagos

"Every brick, every reinforcement rod, every item of furniture – it was all financed by our partners in Austria," said Father Raphael Airoboman, treasurer of the Salesians of Don Bosco in Nigeria, at the official opening of the new street children's shelter in Lagos that was supported by Jugend Eine Welt. The shelter provides a new and safe home for 100 children who had hitherto been forced to live on the dangerous streets of the Nigerian megacity. "I'm very proud that seventy boys and thirty girls now have not only a safe place to sleep and regular meals but also receive psychosocial support to overcome their trauma as well as rehabilitation, school education and training in a trade," says Reinhard Heiserer, director of Jugend Eine Welt.

■ Design for Good Exhibition

"Child labour destroys childhoods": Jugend Eine Welt used this slogan for a large-scale advertising campaign that aimed to increase awareness among people in Austria of types of work that exploit children. India – Mobile Clinic for Children and Mothers-To-Be

Chandigarh, a city in northern India, is beset with enormous problems. Three quarters of the population have barely two euros a day to live on. Slums are spreading, poverty is on the rise. With your support, Jugend Eine Welt is offering help in the form of a mobile clinic in the city. A doctor, a nurse and a laboratory assistant drive around the slums in a minibus, stopping at 21 stations. This enables approximately 30,000 impoverished citizens to take advantage of basic medical services. Children, expectant mothers and older people are given free check-ups and medicines. These services are accompanied by information campaigns on topics such as preventive health care, nutrition and hygiene.



Ecuador – Sustainable Help for Female Small Farmers

“In the past, our only concern was the family’s survival,” explains Maria. “Now our farming is ecological, diversified and adapted to local conditions and even ensures greater yields in the long term.” Guamote, Ecuador’s poorest region, lies in the very heart of the Andean country. Thanks to the support of Jugend Eine Welt and the provincial government of Tyrol, indigenous women who live from small-scale agriculture are receiving vital assistance with attaining food security and preserving their environment. Through courses in agroecological farming techniques such as kitchen gardens, guinea pig breeding, composting, promoting equal rights by reaching decisions together with the men and exchanging traditional types of seed, the project spreads central values that make the good life (buen vivir) possible in a peaceful partnership with no coercion.

Commitment, Public Relations & Global Project Work

28 unpaid staff members in Austria performed various duties for Jugend Eine Welt in 2025. They worked as volunteers on one of our education initiatives, helped with all kinds of office work or provided support at one of the numerous events, where our organisation was involved in. For example: manning information stands.



3.264 voluntary working hours were put in by our volunteers and staff overall. We say a big **THANK-YOU** to each and every one of them.

10 Senior Experts assignments took place in 2025. These men and women from Austria have professional experience and experience of life and contributed their expertise to projects supported by Jugend Eine Welt with great energy and dedication.

3.330 hours of work were put in overall by the Senior Experts at their project locations in 2025. The Vorarlberg native worked at the Bosco Institute for Research and Development on Youth, focusing chiefly on digital documentation and communication.

53 press releases with photos were sent out by the Jugend Eine Welt PR department in 2025. The topics they dealt with – ranging from information on current projects to emergency humanitarian aid to assessments of situations – were widely covered in the mainstream media.



7 social media platforms – Facebook, Instagram, X (Twitter), Bluesky, LinkedIn, YouTube, WhatsApp – provide more than 10,300 followers overall with regular insights into Jugend Eine Welt's work.

in Figures

56 events dealing with education and voluntary work were held in 2025.

23 free talks were given by solicitors throughout Austria on the topic of inheritance law under the "Vergissmeinnicht" scheme in 2025. Jugend Eine Welt was also in attendance to inform participants about ways of making bequests. The organizers even offered online talks, where anybody can participate.



10 apprentices have already completed their training as office administrators at Jugend Eine Welt. Most recently we were able to congratulate Gabriela Berisha on the successful completion of her three-year apprenticeship. Thanks to the donations we receive, we can continue to train young people in Austria as apprentices according to Don Bosco's educational principles.

On Location in Kulmasa, Ghana

In early May, **Dr Magdalena Griebler**, honorary Jugend Eine Welt board member and medical chief of Mariazell health centre, visited Kulmasa, a small town in Ghana's savannah region in the north of the country. Magdalena not only inspected the newly constructed family clinic operated with great dedication by Jugend Eine Welt's project partner the Medical Mission Sisters, but also drew on her medical expertise to offer hands-on support.

Treatment Under the Mango Tree

One of her assignments took the GP from Styria to the remote village of Puro where she helped carry out the regular check-ups under the shade of a mango tree. "These check-ups allow early diagnosis of diseases such as malaria, cholera, typhus, tubercu-

losis and yellow fever," says the experienced doctor. "Serious cases are referred immediately to the newly built family clinic in Kulmasa." Further expansion of the clinic, which was part-financed by Jugend Eine Welt, is planned over the next two years because the demand has grown so much that more wards are already needed to admit new patients.

Emergency Aid After Myanmar Earthquake

Towards the end of March, Myanmar was hit by the most powerful earthquake for nearly a century. According to official figures, the magnitude 7.7 quake caused approximately 5,300 fatalities. Tens of thousands were left homeless.

Destruction was particularly widespread in the city of Mandalay.

The electricity supply was cut off. Basic services came to a virtual standstill. There was a shortage of medical supplies such as trauma kits, blood bags, anaesthetics and critical medication. This was compounded by a severe lack of clean drinking water and sanitary equipment.

Drinking Water, Food, Generators

Under the leadership of Wolfgang Wedan, global relief coordinator, Jugend Eine Welt

launched immediate measures. Together with the Salesians of Don Bosco, local project partners of many years' standing, Jugend Eine Welt distributed aid packages and provided generators so that chargers for mobile phones could be set up. Even now, months later, the level of deprivation is appalling. "It is now children who most need help with overcoming their traumatic experiences," explains Wedan. "As we know from the disaster in Aleppo, major earthquakes are hard to shift from the mind without professional help."

Day for Street Children: Brother Lothar in Austria

Around 31 January, the commemoration day of the young people's saint Don Bosco, Jugend Eine Welt has made it a tradition to highlight the plight of an estimated 150 million street children around the world on the "Day for Street Children". This year, Jugend Eine Welt was able to welcome a very special guest: Brother Lothar.

Powerful insights

German-born Brother Lothar has been working on behalf of the poorest of the poor in West Africa for many years. His work focuses chiefly on minors held in hopelessly overcrowded detention centres and on parentless

children forced to spend their nights in cemeteries, sleeping in graves. In Austria, Brother Lothar's itinerary included a workshop at a secondary school in Pressbaum, Lower Austria, at which he described his work in West Africa in a way the students are unlikely to forget. To demonstrate the inhumane conditions that juvenile inmates have to live in their overcrowded cells, Brother Lothar used tape and four chairs to show how small a 3x2-metre prison cell really is. Ten pupils then tried to find space for themselves on the six square metres. A distressing experience.

The Fight Against Child Labour

As the "Kinderarbeit stoppen" (stop child labour) initiative, which also includes the Dreikönigsaktion der Katholischen Jungschar, FAIRTRADE Austria, solidar Austria and Kindernothilfe Austria, Jugend Eine Welt has campaigned for years for European supply chain legislation that effectively contributes to stopping child labour and other human rights violations.

Aktionen und Gespräche

With strategic campaigns in 2025, the initiative again raised awareness in Austria of the important issue of child labour. These ranged from a dance event in

Vienna's MuseumsQuartier for the World Day Against Child Labour on 12 June to numerous discussions with political decision-makers such as vice-chancellor Babler. The fight against child labour will not end until girls in the Global South are no longer set to work as cheap servants and boys are no longer forced to harvest cocoa beans in the fields. Figures for 2025 show that, around the world, 138 million girls and boys aged between 5 and 17 were still working in conditions that violated their rights.

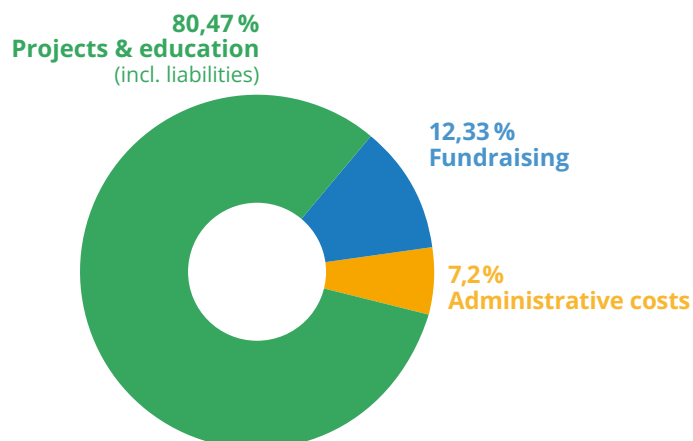

Reinhard Heiserer is “Fundraiser of the Year 2025”



Jugend Eine Welt director honoured at the annual Fundraising Awards of the Fundraising Verband Austria.

In October, Reinhard Heiserer was chosen as the Fundraiser of the Year at the annual Austrian Fundraising Awards ceremony. The Tyrolean, who co-founded Jugend Eine Welt nearly 29 years ago, now joins the ranks of prominent laureates who include Gery Keszler and Michael Landau.

Education Overcomes Poverty

Heiserer is often described as “the head, the heart and the motor of Jugend Eine Welt”. The Tyrolean gathered his first experience of the world of international funding applications during a six-year stint as a volunteer in Ecuador. After a mudslide cut off the country’s electricity supply, Heiserer helped find generous donors who would fund the acquisition of a generator. The years in Ecuador, where the qualified electrician worked primarily with street children, became a kind of “transformer station” for his life to come. Giving children and young people in difficult circumstances the chance to have an education and training was exactly what he wanted to continue doing when he returned to Austria. A starting point for founding the organisation “Jugend Eine Welt”.

EUR 125 million raised as donations

Under Heiserer’s years of leadership, the initially small organisation Jugend Eine Welt has grown to become one of Austria’s biggest organisations for development

cooperation. “Over the past 28 years, Jugend Eine Welt has raised the remarkable total of EUR 125 million in donations and grants – an extraordinary success for a good cause that would not have been possible without the unstinting efforts of Reinhard Heiserer,” said Ruth Williams, director of the Fundraising Verband Austria during the awards ceremony. “This success has its roots in an unequivocal stance, bold messages, a high level of transparency – and a willingness always to break new ground in fundraising.”

Heiserer: “What counts is our ONE world”

“Thank you very much for this prestigious award,” Heiserer replied. “Particularly in times like these when the USA and many governments in Europe – including Austria – are drastically cutting funds for development cooperation in the Global South and focusing increasingly on themselves, it’s important to promote the idea of our ONE WORLD even more vigorously. To paraphrase the Swiss sociologist Jean Ziegler, we do not need to donate more to the people in Africa; it’s enough if we steal less from them! We must give the children and young people hope in the future through school education and the chance to learn a trade. It’s a question of fairness, fair global economic relationships, a healthy environment. What counts is our ONE world which is home to us all; what counts is a “good life (buen vivir) for everyone.”
