# Emergency Aid and Rebuilding After Natural Disasters

In February 2023 a devastating **earthquake** struck the border region between Syria and Turkey. In Syria the earthquake hit a population of whom 90 per cent are already living in poverty because of the ruinous war. The **partners of Jugend Eine Welt** provided urgently needed **emergency aid** and opened the doors of their institutions to the children and their families who have lost everything and face a bleak future.

But our reliable project partners are also on hand to help the people wherever they can in the wake of natural disasters such as **typhoon** Haiyan in the Philippines, the **cyclones** in Myanmar and Mozambique, the **earthquakes** in Haiti, Nepal and Ecuador, the **volcanic eruption** in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, the **floods** in southeast Asia and the **famine** caused by **drought or plagues of locusts** in South Sudan and Ethiopia.

# Help for War Victims and Refugees

Following the invasion by Russian troops in February 2022, countless families were forced to leave Ukraine overnight. The **Jugend Eine Welt project partners** in Ukraine and its neighbouring countries gave fleeing families refuge in their **institutions** from the word "go" and provided them with essential supplies. In addition, Jugend Eine Welt is supporting a **children's hospital** in Odessa with medical equipment and is helping to restore the **energy and drinking water** supply networks that have been destroyed.

But the partners of Jugend Eine Welt also stood by the people during the civil war in **Tigray**, **Ethiopia**. The aid organisation also lends support to the **Palabek** refugee centre in **northern Uganda** where to date almost 60,000 war refugees from **South Sudan** have found **shelter**. The education and training opportunities offered there enable them to start a new life.

## PANDEMICS AND EPIDEMICS

# **Prompt Aid Saves Lives**

Since March 2020, Jugend Eine Welt has supported people in 24 countries particularly badly hit by **COVID** by providing **emergency relief.** The project partners handed out **parcels of food and toiletries** to destitute families in quarantine and during lockdown and also helped in other areas too, such as **emergency supplies** of oxygen, antipyretics and painkillers for hospitals. Children whose parents were in hospital or had died were cared for in Don Bosco centres. There were also large-scale **food aid campaigns for street children.** 

But Jugend Eine Welt also helps when **epidemics** break out. As in 2010 and 2022, for instance, during the **cholera epidemic in Haiti.** Or from 2014 to 2015 when the population of **Sierra Leone** was hit by **ebola.** The partners at "Don Bosco Fambul" focused their assistance particularly on minors whose parents had died of ebola and children banished by their families because they were infected.
